



## SAT▶PSX Converter

The Keiō Saturn to Playstation converter allows you to connect a standard Saturn gamepad to a Playstation 1 or Playstation 2. It is also compatible with a wide range of other converters, allowing it to be used with most other consoles by chaining converters together.

### Features

- Multiple button mapping options
- Autofire
- Tournament mode

To choose the button mapping used by the SAT▶PSX Converter simply hold down whichever button corresponds to the one you want from the table below when plugging the pad in. If you don't hold down any button the converter will remember which setting you used last.

**Start** doesn't do anything on it's own, you have to press it with A, B or C:

Start + A:    Playstation Start  
Start + B:    Playstation Select  
Start + C:    PS3 Home (Start+Select+Up)

**Tournament Mode** disables the Start and Home buttons. When you press the Start button it maps to Playstation Select (no need to press B).

To enter Tournament Mode hold down Start when connecting the gamepad. The LED will flash rapidly for two seconds. To exit Tournament Mode simply unplug the pad and plug it back in again. You can use any button mapping you like with Tournament Mode.

**Mode Y (Autofire)** is specially designed for shoot-em-ups. The A/B/C/L buttons work normally while the X/Y/Z/R buttons provide autofire. This allows you to hold down an autofire button with your thumb most of the time and then rock it back onto the normal button when you want to e.g. charge your power-shot. Another useful technique is use Z for your main weapon and hold it with your index finger, thus allowing you to press A/B/C with your thumb, e.g. for selecting power-ups or firing special weapons.

Note that in Tournament Mode autofire is disabled.
